## 1 ORGANIZATION-WIDE

These fundraisers bring in necessary revenue to the entire organization to help pay for ice time, administration and items that keep the entire organization running. Participation from all skaters and their families is key. Our success is driven by these fundraisers. This season, the fundraisers are:

- **Annual Pig Roast.** Join the BYH barbecue crew at their annual Tailgate Pig Roast & Family BBQ on Friday, September 5 from 5:00-7:00 p.m. at the Brewer Auditorium. Volunteers are needed to prep, staff, clean up after the event... and eat, too!
- **Bottle Drive.** This is a season-long effort. Bring your returnables to Brewer Redemption Center at 85 Betton Street (just off Main Street) in Brewer (989-1802). Be sure to clearly label all your bags with "Brewer YOUTH Hockey" as. Bottles do not have to be pre-counted.
- **Fall & Spring Tag Day.** All skaters will be needed to staff the different shifts at a variety of locations around the Greater Brewer area (Wal-Mart, Lowes, etc.) on October 14, 10am-4pm
- **Raffle.** Tickets for a Ray Bourque autographed hockey stick and gift baskets will be available for purchase during the Annual Pig Roast, Family Fun Night and the Caldwell Tournament. Drawing will be held on Sunday, November 2.

## 2 INDIVIDUAL SKATERS

These selling opportunities are for each player to earn funds that will offset their bill this year. If the player's bill has been paid in full, the amount the player earned will then go as a credit for next year. The more a skater sells, the more money off their bill! A small portion of each sale also goes to the organization to cover production costs. This year, skaters can participate in these fundraisers:

- **ACME Pizza Card.** The new fundraiser enables the individual/seller to earn \$5 off their bill for each \$10 Pizza Card they sell! The card entitles the buyer to free pizza, discounts and specials at Acme Pizza & Wings of Old Town. Use it once and it pays for itself! Buy them for yourself and use them when you play at the Alford!
- **Mia Bella Soy Candle Sale.** This new fundraiser will start in September and end October 7... perfect for getting your holiday shopping done early! These environmentally friendly candles will be available in the 12 most popular scents for just \$20 each. Skater's earn \$4 off their bill for each candle sold!
- **Holiday Wreaths.** The wreaths will be fully decorated and be sold at a very reasonable price. Selling will start in October.
